Project Requirements


To perform a thorough review of the pilot manuscript assigned for text and image research and prepare a detailed source and permissions log.

Challenges

- Source information was missing in the supplied manuscript files.
- Manuscript files received in multiple batches
- 550+ image assets; 100+ text assets, 500+ pages
- Updated version of art logs were received after the first round of review.
- The client's team was new to the rights and permissions (R&P) process and relied on guidance and support from the Amnet team.

Solution Approach

- **Resource Allocation:** Amnet deployed an experienced rights and permissions (R&P) research specialist and a dedicated project manager to collaborate with the client.
- **Template creation:** Prior to beginning work on the project, Amnet prepared a template for permissions log per the client's requirements and received the client's approval.
- **Manuscript review:** Detailed MS assessment and logging of third-party assets and source information.
- Assessment log creation: Preparation of a detailed log indicating the source and copyright status, as applicable, for each asset.
- **Query Resolution and Tracking:** Efficient query resolution and structured communication with the client, keeping in view the high asset count.
- **Proactive collaboration by PM:** Proactive collaboration with the client and regular updates on project progress.



Workflow improvement suggestions from Amnet


To streamline the R&P process for future projects, the Amnet team proposed improvements to the client's workflow, which the client gladly accepted, thus facilitating enhanced collaboration.
