## Challenges

## Objectives

Improving reviewer selection procedures to enhance operational effectiveness and the peer review process itself.

## Solution

Amnet studied the underlying concerns that were resulting in the client's challenges and introduced the following changes:

- 1) Diversification in the reviewer selection process, which ensured a higher response rate from reviewers.
- 2) Team was trained to select the correct keywords/strings, which helped to identify the best reviewers.
- 3) Enhanced the curated list of the reviewer database. Furthermore, encouraged the team to search for reviewers using PubMed, Google Scholar, and Web of Science.
- 4) Also worked on expanding the targeted group of reviewers (early-career researchers or experienced researchers)

## Benefits

Acceptance rate by reviewers increased from 6% to 10%. This had a direct effect on the impact factor of the journals. This further led to an increase in the submission count of the journals.
